Book Week Parade

This event takes place on our basketball court **from 9.10am**, after classes have completed role call and morning announcements.

Families are welcome to stay on site after morning drop-off to the classroom and join their student, who will need to be waiting with their teacher and class for their turn in the parade. The parade will start with our Junior classes, our earlier grades going first.

Family members are welcome to walk with their student in the parade when they are following their classroom teacher. Non-school aged children on site **MUST** be supervised by parents/carers whilst on site at all times.

The Parade is an outdoor event and will be dependent on the weather on the day. If it is too windy or wet, we still encourage our students to come in their costumes and they will be able to celebrate the day in their classrooms. Photos will be shared via Seesaw for families to see their students.

Some reminders:

- **NO TOY WEAPONS** are to be used as part of a costume. Weapons brought by *students will be removed till the end of the day.*
- *Encourage students to bring a change of clothes in case they become overheated or cold.*

These are fun awards, selected by students in the SRC who will give up their Friday lunch to carefully review class photos and select the Most Creative Costume with a consensus vote.*
