Next week we are excited to implement our Whole School Transition Program for students. From Monday to Wednesday students will meet their 2025 classroom teacher and peers. We have been planning these three days very thoughtfully for the previous month, with a Transition Team leading the way. Classroom teachers have also had additional planning time to help organise the three days.

Our 2025 Foundation students will also join us for a longer transition visit on Tuesday, while our Grade 6 students will venture off to their secondary school destinations. It's a very exciting time for our new Foundation students and our Grade 6 students as they finish up their schooling at YPS and journey onto secondary schooling.

Mr. James Shields will be able to join his 3/4 class on Tuesday the 10th of December. We thank his current school for his release to enable him to meet our students and staff.

The purpose of our transition program is to ensure all students feel safe and supported in their new classroom environment and that any student with additional learning needs are organised and prepared to start the school year. Our transition program involves collaborative planning between teachers and Specialists, students and families.

Classrooms will spend time getting to know each other building relationships, classroom routines based on our school values, teamwork activities and games and establishment of learning investigations for next year. It's a really important time to spend together. Students will also spend time in our four Specialist classes including PE, STEM, Visual Arts and Auslan.

We are confident our transition program will provide just the right level of support for all our students.

We thank your for your assistance in this matter.




Please Look After Our Gardens



(This dinner is for students and Grade 5/6 staff only).



How Do I Access the Funds?

You should have already received an email for each of your children with an access code to log in to the SSB Portal. The email was sent from **Department of Education Victoria** <normalises <normalise

The emails were only sent to the first parent in the family ("Parent A"). They were not sent to both parents. Please check your spam/junk folders if you have not received it.

What Children Are Eligible?

Eligibility is defined by the Department, see the <u>SSB website for more information</u>.

How do I use the SSB funds to purchase uniform?

You will need your login code from the email (see above) you cannot use the SSB without it. In the SSB Portal you can generate a code that you can use to make a purchase at our uniform shop (BELEZA -Warragul) You can only purchase items available from the uniform shop, you cannot use the funds at other stores. The code you received by email is your login code to the SSB Portal, you can use it to generate purchasing codes.

How can I use the SSB funds to pay for school activities (camps & excursions)?

The SSB Funds are intended for 2025 school activities. You will need to log in to the SSB Portal and transfer the funds to the school using the School Activity option. Please see the help guides on the SSB website for information on how to do this – we cannot do it for you or on your behalf at the school.

The funds do not expire, so you will not lose them.

My Child is in Year 6, how do I access the funds?

Funds for Year 6 students are only accessible through their high school. The SSB is intended for 2025 activities, so you will need to contact your child's high school to use the SSB funds.

Compass entries, phone calls and SMS messages are sent. In the event that parents can not be contacted, or do not respond, we will be calling your listed emergency contacts.









Yarragon Primary School and Early Learning Centre has been officially approved as a donation partner for Victoria's Container Deposit Scheme (CDS Vic).

We have made keyrings with our Partner ID. Feel free to keep it for yourself or give to a neighbour, friend, relative or community group.

What can I return? Most aluminium, glass, plastic and liquid paperboard (carton) drink containers between 150mL and 3 litres are eligible.

Look for the 10c mark on the drink container label. It is often located near the barcode.

We recommend you don't crush containers.
